

## Example 6

### Types of Donor-Imposed Barriers

The table below gives some examples of types of barriers a donor could impose.

Type of Barrier	Measurable Metric	Example
<b>Measurable performance-related</b>	Specific outcome, certain level of service, identified number of units	A nonprofit receives a certain amount of money contingent upon the nonprofit raising matching funds
<b>Stipulation related to the purpose of the agreement</b>	Additional activity or event (generally excludes administrative tasks and trivial situations)	Funding to address cybersecurity risks is contingent on the institution engaging an external consultant to perform a cybersecurity risk assessment
<b>Limited discretion by recipient</b>	Specific guidance on how assets should be spent	A grant that is designated for a specific program or activity
<b>Requires additional action</b>	Additional action(s) taken for a new or existing activity	The recipient is required to expand its facility
